The Rules

- 1. Be on time, on task, and prepared every day. This includes bringing materials to class.
- 2. Pick up any trash that you see, especially yours. We have two wastebaskets in the room. Use them.
- 3. Be responsible for your own learning. Cheating won't help you. This includes Al.
- 4. Be respectful and do what you are asked to do. I promise there's a method to the madness.
- 5. Remember the cell phone/earbuds/headphones/smart watch policies so that I do not have to remind you.

Procedures

Place completed work in the appropriate bin. Work should not be laid on my desk or podium unless you are directed to do so.

Phones and earbuds do not have a place in my classroom. Please do not use them during class time. I give a warning for devices first. If I have to direct you a second time, your cell phone/earbuds go into a stapled paper bag. The paper bag must remain closed for the remainder of the block. If it is opened and you are caught again that block, you will receive a referral. After three "paper bag warnings," no warnings will be given. A referral is immediate.

Please do not adjust the thermostat in my classroom. I am the only person that should be controlling it. If you have an issue, please speak with me.

Any worksheets for the day will be on the work table for you to pick up. Minimal additional copies will be made. Extra copies will be in the stackable bin on the worktable.

Late work will get an immediate 10-point deduction. Additional points will be deducted for every day the work is late. I do not accept late work beyond two weeks after its due date.

Trips to the bathroom must be documented by signing out and back in. There is a QR Code to scan to make this process easier. You must carry a pass with you when leaving class.

If you borrow materials from my classroom, please use them respectfully and return them promptly.

Seating is different in this classroom than in any other on campus. This is called flexible seating. If you abuse the privilege, you do not enjoy the benefits of flexible seating and will have a permanent regular desk. Seats will be rotated every two weeks. If you tear up my furniture, you will receive a referral, lose flexible seating privileges permanently, and be expected to replace any damaged items. If you complain about someone being in "your seat," I assign your seat for the remainder of the class. Choose your words.

Homework is a rare occurrence in my class. Please use your time wisely in class to avoid having to do tons of work outside of class. Do not waste the opportunities you are given.
