What is satire?

* Satire is sarcasm, irony, or wit used to make fun of something or someone more serious.

* Horation satire is tolerant, witty, wise, and self-effacing.

Juvenalian


* Juvenalian satire is angry, caustic, resentful, and personal.

Satirical Tool 2: Dramatic Irony

What is dramatic irony?

* Dramatic irony is when one character does or says something not knowing something in the plot that affects that character.

Satirical Tool 3: Situational Irony

What is situational irony?

* Situational irony is when there is a discrepancy, or a lack of similarity, between two events.

Satirical Tool 4: Travesty

What is travesty?

* Travesty is taking a serious subject and making it seem not important.

Satirical Tool 5: Parody

What is parody?

* Parody takes a serious work and imitates it to make fun of it in a silly way.

Satirical Tool 6: Exaggeration/Hyperbole

What is hyperbole?

* Hyperbole/Exaggeration is when one makes something small seem much bigger, grander than it actually is.

What is an example of hyperbole?




Satirical Tool 7: Understatement

Satirical Tool 8: Malapropism

What is malapropism?

* Malapropism is mispronouncing something on purpose in order to poke fun of it.
