- 6. What new information does Mrs. Mallard learn near the end of the story regarding the fate of her husband? How does she learn this? What is her reaction?
- 7. From what point of view is the story told? Provide your reasoning.
- 8. What is the overall mood of the story? How does it change? Explain using evidence from the story.
- 9. Describe one example of situational irony and one of dramatic irony in the story. Explain why each is an example of irony.
- 10. What is a possible theme of this story? Explain your answer using evidence from the text.
